Obviously we're not out of the woods yet with the threat of Covid 19 yet and as a PCC we have put in some precautions to make sure that we all protect one another.




Firstly and most importantly, **if you don't feel well or have any symptoms of Covid 19 please stay at home.** We will still be live streaming our services, so anyone who isn't able to join us at the moment won't miss out!



Please **use the hand sanitizer** on the welcome table when you arrive. There will also be a dispenser by the exit for you to use as you leave.



Please **do not arrive too early**, we need to keep the amount of time we are together as brief as possible. At the end of the service please **leave promptly**, starting with those nearest the exit.



At all times please **keep at least 2 metres apart** from anyone who doesn't live with you.

The chairs have been arranged in line with government guidance, please don't move them. They have been grouped to allow people from the same household to sit together.



Please **follow the one way system** through the church, you will be directed and there will be plenty of arrows so you don't get lost!

### Contact Tracing

The government have asked that we record the names of anyone who comes into the church building. Should anyone attending then be diagnosed or show symptoms of Covid 19, we would be able to contact you so that you can take the appropriate action. Please would you complete a contact tracing slip and leave it on your seat when you leave? We will keep your details securely and destroy them after 21 days.
